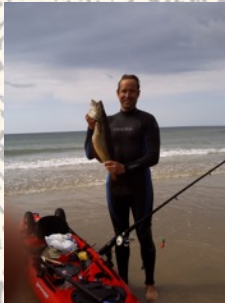


# 2012 Sit on Kayaks.co.uk



Sit On Top kayaks manufactured by Islander Kayaks, Feel-free, Tootega and Wilderness Systems. These brands have been chosen for their quality and modern design. We have a great deal of experience designing custom wave skis (but haven't had time to produce our own rotomoulded ones yet!) and kayaks; these models come close to the recreational/surf models we would design ourselves. Compact lightweight models like the Pulse 85 are easy to handle and transport and the Paradise is a firm favourite with us. The Tarpon series are undoubtedly top of the range touring kayaks when it comes to design and outfitting. All rotomoulded in superlinear polyethylene..

**Tootega Pulse 85**   
2.6m x 72cm 16kg capacity 14st/90kg

The best surfing sit on top and an ideal beach kayak for small to medium sized paddlers, particularly good for kids. The lightest model we offer - this is a very nice looking kayak which is comfortable and stable for it's width with some good features. The channelled and continuously rockered hull with a very lifted bow make it very manoeuvrable in the surf but retain enough grip to ride along a steep wave face. Built in carry handles at the bow and stern and effective grips in the centre. Cockpit hatch, rear cargo well and recessed fittings to take Tootega seat (£35) and thighstraps.




**Tootega Pulse 95**   
2.9m x 75cm 19kg capacity 20st/125kg

Ideal surf and beach kayak for the larger paddler which is versatile enough to be used for exploring both the coastline and rivers. Also available in Huntsman spec for anglers looking for a compact fishing kayak with a stable hull design. Built in carry handles and a handy centre hatch, a bit lighter than equivalent models. Recessed anchor points for the optional backrest (£35) and thighstraps.




**Islander Paradise**  **(inc backrest) £342**  
**2.85m x 75cm 18kg Capacity 16st/100kg (optimum max 14st)**

One of our favourite models, the Paradise is a delight to paddle for small to medium sized paddlers with its sleek bow and low drag hull design. The sides are angled up toward the seat meaning that a good paddle stroke can be performed from the excellent seating position without banging your hands on the edge. You really have to be paddling a 12ft kayak to go significantly faster than the Paradise.

Fitted with a rear hatch and captive bag, small tankwell with cargo straps, a surf backrest with rear pocket, twin toggles and side carrying handles.



**Islander Calypso**  (inc surf backrest) **£360**  
**3.0m x 75cm 20kg capacity 22st/145kg (optimum max 20st)**

Excellent all-rounder with a high capacity but very comfortable for paddlers of all sizes. A fine uplifted bow with lots of flare gives dry directional paddling yet the stable centre hull section makes it very stable. Good for all sea conditions. Plenty of room in the cockpit which has moulded-in footrests and a small hatch as well as the larger bow hatch. A large rear tankwell and rear deck designed to take fishing rod holders also make this a great budget fishing kayak. Excellent moulded-in side carry handles.

**Feelfree Nomad** **£342/360 with wheel**  
**3.0m x 75cm 20kg Capacity 20st/125kg (optimum max 18st)**

A good all-round kayak with a high capacity for larger paddlers. A reassuring deep seat and a good supportive curve for the lower back, especially when a surf backrest is fitted. A very popular style which will take the user from beach and sheltered water to an exciting paddle along the coast. Also very good in the surf. Equipped with a central hatch with mesh bag inside. Excellent moulded-in side carry handles.

Recommended accessory: feelfree deluxe backrest £55. Thighstraps for surfing £30



**Wilderness Systems Tarpon 100**   
**3.0m x 77cm 23kg Capacity 23st/145kg (optimum max 18st)**

Well designed short touring model with easily the highest specification of any brand of kayak at this size. Ideal for the beach, lake, fishing, touring etc. the Tarpon 100 can do just about anything and is a wonderful all-rounder. Twin hatches which can be opened with one hand and large rear well and the fantastic Wilderness Systems Phase5 seating system. Also fitted with the new SlideTrax accessory system.

The hull of the 2009 model is a little beamier but with more flared and rockered bow and stern giving a dry ride in choppy seas. As with all the models in the Tarpon range the hull is a conventional touring/sea kayak hull meeting the best performance/stability criteria, a design that has been evolved over hundreds of years and is found on most boats as well.

**Wilderness Systems Tarpon 120**  **£605**  
**3.6m x 71cm 25kg Capacity 25st/160kg (optimum max 19st)**

Start to feel the difference with faster paddling speed and superb tracking. Extra rocker makes the 120 well suited to venturing further on larger expanses of open water or the coast. A little narrower than the 100 with a fine flared bow and stern. Large front hatch and huge rear tankwell, medium sized hatch in the cockpit and integrated height adjustable deluxe padded backrest.



**Wilderness Systems Tarpon 140** **£720**  
**4.3m x 71cm 28kg Capacity 27st/170kg (optimum max 18st)**

Superb touring sit on kayak, fast and stable with good seaworthiness and plenty of storage. Very sleek lines with plenty of flare for a dry ride. Comfortable paddling position with integrated deluxe backrest and adjustable footrests. Large bow hatch and medium hatch in the cockpit with huge rear tankwell.



**Wilderness Systems Tarpon 160i**

**£820**

**4.9m x 71cm 30kg Capacity 28st/180kg (optimum max 18st)**

A completely different boat to the previous 160. This new model has the speed, freeboard and flared bow to get you across choppy bays faster than ever. Excellent speed and acceleration

Fitted with the (super comfortable) legendary "phase 3" seat/backrest combination and "slidetrax" accessory system for virtually limitless add-ons. The new easy locking hatches and accessory pockets provide convenient storage together with the extra large rear tankwell.

A fisherman's dream, all the usual moulded-in points for fitting rod holders and acc's.

**Angling versions**

**Tarpons - plus £140**

Angling versions come with 2 x rear flushmount rod holders, one scotty articulated rod holder fitted by UMP on the slidetrax and anchor with line and cleat. Fitted by us with a big saving on factory fitted: does not affect your warranty.

**Alternatively, from £30**, we can fit the full range of "Scotty" rod and accessory holders and anchors which we can quickly fit enabling a more cost-effective, custom outfitting. These options can be fitted to virtually all single and double sit-on kayaks and many kayaks and open canoes.




**Islander Paradise Tandem**  **(inc backrests) £450**  
**4.0m x 85cm 30kg Capacity 200kg/32st (optimum max 26st)**

Easily the best tandem there is for solo paddling or paddling with a child or smaller paddler in the front. Like the solo version the Paradise double has a very fine bow and a clean efficient hull for minimum drag. A deep, narrow keel means it tracks exceptionally well in cross winds with lighter (or single) paddlers and the narrow deck allows for that all-important proper paddle stroke. Exciting to paddle yet still has ample stability for small to average sized paddlers. The centre seat for solo paddling is properly moulded and has associated moulded-in footrests (nb. centre seat cannot be used for a passenger).

Fitted with a central hatch with captive bag, small rear tankwell with cargo straps, 2 surf backrests with rear pockets, endgrabs and side handles



**Wilderness Systems Tarpon 130 tandem**  **£540**  
**4.0m x 86cm 30kg Capacity 250kg/40st (optimum max 36 st)**

An exceptionally versatile double which can be paddled solo or double and comes with integral hinged seats and 2 small hatches. Maximum use has been made of the interior space to allow children to travel with adults, we know of one family of five using it all together!!

This double paddles extremely well due to the fine flared bow and the integral skeg at the stern giving a comfortable, dry ride. A lovely stable paddle for larger paddlers for whom the integral backrests give unequalled support to the lower back. For families it has proven more popular than triple kayaks because of the extra legroom in the cockpit.



**Feelfree Gemini Tandem**

**£450**

**3.8m x 83cm 31kg capacity 32st / 200kg**


New model with deeply placed seats for a reassuring paddle and with a small "kiddie" seat in the middle. A fairly slim hull makes it reasonably easy to paddle by smaller paddlers too. Features an integral wheel in the keel, excellent moulded in carry handles, cargo well and two hatches with integral mesh bags.

Recommended accessories: Feelfree deluxe seats £55 each. Canvas seats £35 each

**330cm x 75cm 25kg capacity 22st/ 140kg**

A very capable short touring and fishing kayak with 2 large hatches at a great price. Also available in the higher specification "Huntsman" angling version and "Prophecy" deluxe version. Loads of storage space for a kayak of this size with good speed and stability from it's double concave hull.

**410cm x 73cm 28kg capacity 25st / 160kg**

A swift touring hull which tracks extremely well with neutral handling. A very well specified kayak for the price with two hatches, backrest and twin flushmount rod holders. Lots of on deck storage space, Huntsman edition available in "inland camo" (shown).
